Graduation Requirements

- 1. Students must successfully complete a "Capstone Experience." This requirement may be satisfied with POLS 4370 Senior Research Seminar.
- 2. Students must use their remaining 41 credit hours to obtain a minor and/or second major in a different discipline. After earning enough credits for a minor and/or second major in a different discipline, students may choose Political Science Advanced courses, or a second minor, or use as Advanced Electives in other disciplines.
- 3. In addition to the graduation requirements listed in the UTRGV 2017-2019 Undergraduate Catalog, demonstration of proficiency in a language other than English is required at the undergraduate level equivalent to a minimum of six credit hours. Proficiency can be demonstrated by a college credit exam, a placement test approved through the UTRGV department of Writing and Language Studies, and/or to six credit hours of college-level language coursework.
